### 1.1 Send Us a Copyright Form

- Deadline for authors (invited as well as regular): **November 3, 2007**.

- One author may sign on behalf of all the other authors of a paper, *but if an author has multiple papers accepted, we need one copyright form per each paper*. Digital signatures are acceptable.

## 1.2 Register Yourself for the Conference

- Deadline of early registration for contributing authors: **November 16, 2007**, for student authors: **November 23, 2007**.
- At least one author of each accepted paper must register for the conference and present the results at the conference. Student papers are to be presented by students, so at least one student has to register. Please register at

- To qualify for an early registration, your fee should arrive to the conference bank account not later than on **December 1, 2007**, or a filled and signed form for credit card payment to the organizers by **November 26, 2007**.

## 1.3 Send Your Article

- Deadline for invited speakers: **October 19, 2007**, contributing authors: **November 6, 2007**, student papers: **November 16, 2007**.
- The length of your camera-ready contribution should not exceed the page limit given above, using the Springer's document class `lncs` for L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub>. This class file can be obtained from

- Pack, e.g., with `zip`, the following files and send them to [sofsem08@ics.upjs.sk](mailto:sofsem08@ics.upjs.sk):
  - \* the source `tex` files,
  - \* all further style files and fonts you have used (so that the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X compilation works without installing any extra packages),
  - \* the `pdf` file of your paper (this is required for comparison with our compilation),
  - \* a `readme.txt` file with the name and email address of the *contact author* of your paper and also information which of your names is/are your *first name(s)* and which is/are your *family name(s)*.

## 1.4 Keep Checking for Emails from Springer

- Around **December 9, 2007**, the contact author will receive an email from India with the final pdf file of his/her paper. You will be asked to check it for mistakes and send the list of corrections back to the address it came from.
- Make sure that the contact author has *access to email* in those days and that emails with attachments are *not automatically filtered out*.

## 2 Some Details about Your L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X Paper

**Your T<sub>E</sub>X File.** For the preparation for your file please use L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub> with the Springer document class `lncs.cls`. You are encouraged use the template file `lncs.dem` which can be obtained from the above address. Please cancel any superfluous definitions that are not actually used in your text.

**Do not change the default paper size or the default font size!**

**Cross-References.** Please use the commands `\label` and `\ref` for cross-references and the commands `\bibitem` and `\cite` for the references to the bibliography.

**Figures.** For more details see `typeinst.pdf`, Subsection 2.1 “Figures”. Figures should be inserted using the `\includegraphics` command which is included in the standard L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub> packages `graphics` or `graphicx`. Please refrain from using the `\special` command. Figures should be numbered and should have a caption positioned *under* the figures, in contrast to the caption belonging to a table, which should always appear *above* the table; this is achieved as matter of sequence in your source. Please center the figures or your tabular material by using the `\centering` declaration. Please define figures (and tables) as floating objects and *avoid using optional location parameters* like “[h]” for “here”.

**Colored Figures.** In the printed volume, the illustrations are black and white (halftones), and only in exceptional cases, and if the author is prepared to cover the extra cost for color reproduction, are colored pictures accepted. Colored pictures are welcome in the electronic version free of charge. If you send colored figures that are to be printed in black and white, please make sure that they really are legible in black and white. Some colors as well as the contrast of converted colors show up very poorly when printed in black and white.

**Headings.** Headings should be capitalized, for more details see `lncsdoc.pdf`, Subsection 4.2 “Capitalization and Non-capitalization” or `typeinst.pdf`, Section 2 “Paper Preparation”.

**Built-in Environments.** The document class `lncs.cls` provides the following environments: `claim`, `conjecture`, `corollary`, `definition`, `example`, `exercise`, `lemma`, `note`, `problem`, `proof`, `property`, `proposition`, `question`, `remark`, `solution`, `theorem`. For more details, see `lncsdoc.pdf`, Sections 8 and 9; “Predefined Theorem like Environments” and “Defining Your Own Theorem like Environments”.

**Equations.** Displayed equations should be inserted using `\begin{equation}\label{...} ... \end{equation}` for numbered formulas and `\begin{equation*}... \end{equation*}`, `\[... \]` or `$$...$$` for unnumbered formulas. Please reference the formulas symbolically using the `\ref` command. Please punctuate displayed equations in the same way as ordinary text but with a small space `\;` before the end punctuation.

**Program Code.** Program listings or program commands in the text are normally set in the typewriter font, e.g., CMTT10 or Courier. We recommend using the `\begin{verbatim} ... \end{verbatim}` command.

**References.** The list of references should be made using the standard `\begin{thebibliography}`, `\end{thebibliography}` command. For citations please use the `\cite` command. For more details see `llncsdoc.pdf`, Section 17 “References”.

**Running Heads.** If your paper title is too long to serve as a running head, it will be shortened. Your suggestion as to how to shorten it is most welcome, see `llncsdoc.pdf`, Section 6 “Special Commands for the Volume Editor”.

**Acknowledgments.** This section should be inserted using the command `\subsubsection*{Acknowledgments.}`
